

ABOUT THE RFA/HOCHSTEIN JUNIOR FLUTE CAMP



Junior Flute Camp (grades 5-6) is a mini version of the ever popular RFA/Hochstein Flute Camp (grades 6-12).

This collaborative offering with the Rochester Flute Association provides an opportunity for younger flute students to develop their skills while making new friends in a lively, supportive setting. Daily activities will include group lessons, ensemble playing, games, and special workshops.

Junior Flute Camp will conclude with a brief performance on Friday, July 14, 2017.

Junior Camp is recommended for students who have played the flute for at least one year, have performed or studied music at NYSSMA level 1 (or equivalent), and who will be entering grades 5-6 in September 2017. Younger students may be considered based on teacher recommendation.

ABOUT THE TEACHERS

Alexandra Barbato

Rochester native, Alexandra Barbato, is a flutist, pianist, and organist. Alexandra earned a Master of Music degree in flute performance from SUNY Fredonia in 2014, studying under Dr. Susan Royal, and a Bachelor of Music degree in music performance from Nazareth College, studying with Dr. Marjorie Roth. She is currently a full accompanist in the Webster School District and is the pianist at St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Bloomfield, NY. She maintains a private studio of flute and piano students, and teaches through The Music Store in Webster and the Rochester Contemporary School of Music.

Along with being a faculty member of the flute camp, Alexandra was the director of the Rochester Flute Association's flute ensemble, and is continuing her position as Corporate Membership Director of the RFA. Alexandra plays with several ensembles including the Perinton Concert Band, Eastside Swingtet, Center Stage Pops Symphony Orchestra, and substitutes with the Finger Lakes Symphony Orchestra.

Ashley Moss

Ashley G. Moss currently teaches band and general music for the Rochester City School District in Rochester, New York. In addition, she serves as the director of the Early Childhood Music Program at Roberts Wesleyan College Community Music School. In the summer, Ashley regularly presents at local and state music education functions, performs with the Perinton Concert Band, and subs in ensembles in the greater Rochester region.

Prior to returning to the Rochester area, Ashley completed her Master of Music in Music Education at Michigan State University in East Lansing, Michigan. While there, she served on the early childhood music teaching staff at the Michigan State University Community Music School and taught courses in early childhood and elementary general music to teacher education majors. Ashley completed a Bachelor of Science in Music education at Roberts Wesleyan College in 2011, where she studied flute with Diane Smith and taught private flute lessons with the Community Music School.
