New Hochstein Holiday Prism Concert Showcases Variety of Musical Styles in Unique Format

December 17 concert in Hochstein Performance Hall

ROCHESTER, N.Y.—On **Saturday, December 17, at 4:00 pm**, the Hochstein School of Music & Dance hosts its first-ever **Holiday Prism Concert** in Hochstein Performance Hall. Similar to Hochstein's annual Presberg Ensembles Concert, the Holiday Prism Concert features ensembles from Hochstein's chamber music, jazz, and instrumental programs, which will be set up in different parts of the hall. The performance runs continuously for about an hour with applause held until the very end. The concert includes festive holiday music by string quartets, piano trio, woodwind quintet, guitar ensemble, flute choir, ukulele ensemble, jazz combo, and HochStrings Adult Chamber Orchestra. The concert is free and open to the public.

Hochstein Ensembles Coordinator Diane Smith says, "The unique prism concert format gives us an opportunity to showcase the talents of our various instrumental ensembles, as well as the wide range of musical styles at Hochstein, from classical to jazz and folk music." A prism concert is designed to feature many different groups of performers for a fast-paced, creative concert experience.
