

Dance Faculty Bios:

Cheryl Johnson (Tap, Jazz, Musical Theatre)

Ms. Johnson has performed off Broadway, at international dance festivals, in music videos, on TV specials, in nightclubs, and in touring dance companies. In Seattle, she was the dance consultant to the Jimi Hendrix Museum: Experience Music Project and an ambassador of rhythm tap dance hosting festivals, master classes, educational programs, and creating choreography for musical theatre and the concert stage. In NYC, she was a member of Gail Conrad's Tap Dance Theatre, Jerry Ames Tap Dance Company, and performed as a pioneer dancer for the original creation of MTV. In Rochester, NY she has enjoyed gigs with the likes of the Vision of Sound Original Music & Dance Concert Series, Bill Evans Dance Company, NYS Dance Force Duets Concerts, the NYC New Mix Performance Festival, the Key Bank Rochester Fringe Festivals and collaborations with the Richard DeLaney jazz trio. Cheryl is a dance educator at the University of Rochester, Nazareth University, and The Hochstein School where she also works with the Expressive Arts Program.

Janalyce Lane (Beginning Modern, Latin Dance)

Janalyce Lane is a Rochester native and Hochstein Alum, previously a Senior Company Member of Borinquen Dance Theater. In addition to being the Beginners Modern Dance and Latin Dance instructor at Hochstein, she is also a freelance performer who is involved in annual community shows. She holds a Bachelors degree in Psychology from Binghamton University, and works full-time with foster children at a local non-profit

Diane Lewis (Classical Ballet)

Ms. Lewis holds a Master's Degree in Dance from SUNY Brockport, a Bachelor's Degree in Education from Buffalo State University, and is a former member of SUNY Brockport Dance Faculty. Ms. Lewis trained in the Vaganova technique and has worked professionally with Kathleen Crofton, Rudolph Nureyev, Bronislava Nijinska, Alicia Markova and Eva Evdokimova. Ms. Lewis has toured and Europe and the USA as a soloist with the American Classical Ballet and the Festival Ballet of New York. As a principal with the Niagara Frontier Ballet. Ms Lewis performed the Mazurka opposite famous Margot Fonteyn's Prelude in Les Sylphides at the Eastman Theatre. Ms Lewis chaired the Dance department at Hochstein for over 40 years. She now enjoys teaching, choreographing, restaging the classics, and coaching master classes.

Wynton Rice (Modern Dance, Dance Department Chair)

Wynton Rice is a native Rochesterian who spent 10 years performing internationally with the Garth Fagan Dance Company. He recently joined the Rochester based contemporary dance company BIODANCE. Wynton also taught at the Garth Fagan Dance School, including dance fundamentals classes for teens and adults, and taught dance for grades K-8 at Eugenio Maria de Hostos Charter School in Rochester. In addition to teaching and serving as an artist-in-residence for schools, he taught a jazz/ballet fusion class at the National Youth Dance Theater in New South Wales, Australia. He holds a Bachelor's Degree in Dance from Ursinus College in Collegeville, PA.

Adrianne Santucci (African Dance & Drumming)

Adrianne has taught a Multi-cultural, Intergenerational program of African Dance & Culture for the City of Rochester Department of Recreation and is a teaching artist for (children's theatre) at Kuumba Consultants. She is also a member of Sankofa and Mounafanyi African Dance & Drum Ensembles.

Vanessa Watters (Mini-Dancers, Pre-Ballet, Ballet I)

Vanessa Watters attended the University of Southern California, earning both a Bachelor's and a Master's Degree in Vocal Arts. She trained with the Los Angeles Civic Light Opera Musical Theatre Workshop, and danced and sang professionally in musical theatre productions throughout Southern California. A long-time ballet student of Stanley Holden, former principal dancer with the Royal Ballet, she taught ballet for many years and also headed a ballet program for the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks. In addition to teaching dance as well as in the Expressive Arts Department here at Hochstein, she teaches ballet for the Perinton Community Center, and studies Dance/Movement Therapy with Danielle Fraenkel of Kinections Studio.
