JOHN ROLLAND holds a Bachelors degree in Music Education and a Masters degree in Wind Conducting from SUNY Fredonia where he was the School of Music's first graduate assistant in conducting. He is an instrumental music teacher and coordinator of the music department at Bay Trail Middle School in Penfield, NY. Prior to Penfield, Mr. Rolland taught at Northport High School on Long Island where he directed the concert band, jazz ensemble, chamber winds and was assistant director of the Northport Tiger Marching Band.

Mr. Rolland is Director of Bands at the Hochstein School of Music and Dance and is a frequent guest conductor of junior and senior high honor bands throughout New York State. He has served as Interim Director of the Cassadaga Area Concert Band and Music Director of the East End Chamber Orchestra (Long Island, NY).

As a percussionist, Mr. Rolland has performed regularly with the Atlantic Wind Symphony and Western New York Chamber Orchestra. He is a percussion instructor with the Gates-Chili High School Marching Band and a former front ensemble instructor with the White Sabers Drum and Bugle Corps. He continues to maintain an active performance schedule in and around the Rochester area.

PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

Interested students must be capable of working independently and accepting responsibility. All participants will be expected to learn their music thoroughly prior to the first rehearsal. Music will be mailed by **August 4, 2018**.

Applicants must have received a NYSSMA score during the 2017-2018 school year of at least Excellent (21) for Levels 3 & 4 or A- (90) for Levels 5 & 6 **OR** for those who have not received the required NYSSMA score, please submit an MP3 by email or CD* of appropriate repertoire.

Following are the minimum NYSSMA solo levels for each instrument:

Level 4: Piccolo, flute, oboe, alto saxophone, snare drum

Level 3: Clarinet, bass clarinet, bassoon, tenor and baritone saxophone, trumpet, French horn, trombone, euphonium, tuba, percussion (keyboard and timpani)

FIRST CHAIR

To be considered for first chair placement in a section, submit an MP3 by email or CD* indicative of current playing level (maximum length of 10 minutes).

PLEASE label all MP3 or CD submissions with one or both of the following:

- Replacement for NYSSMA scores
- Audition for 1st chair
