ROCHESTER, N.Y.— For those who have always dreamt of writing music, making visual art, or writing stories but are intimidated by the act of creation, The Hochstein School now offers the opportunity to discover that creativity is a skill that can be cultivated and practiced like any other skill. Thanks to the imaginative genius of faculty member Dave Chisholm, director of the former "Music Lab," Hochstein's offerings have been reconfigured to turn the Lab into an innovative, creative, and vibrant space where anyone ages 12 and up can explore endless possibilities.

Hochstein's **Creativity Lab** will offer lessons, short-run workshops, and pop-up events starting on Saturday, October 14. Topics include composing music, making comic books, improvisation, music theory, and songwriting. The Saturday afternoon pop-up events are free; there is a charge for the short-run workshops. Space is limited and advance registration is requested. The Creativity Lab will also have open hours when you can drop in and try out the space, which has 8 iMac computers and piano keyboards.
